Sharing Our Vision

This is an exciting time to be at Mt. Hope! After celebrating over 80 years of ministry, God has given us a fresh vision for our future. God is calling us to fulfill the very name He gave us - Mt. Hope! We want to be a community where people DISCOVER and DELIVER the Hope of Jesus.

What Are We Working On?

After much prayer and consultation, the leadership feels called to help our congregation focus on two key areas:

Focus # 1-Investing into children by first creating a compelling children's center (the former west wing).

We know that children are close to the heart of God! The Bible tells us in Mark 9:37 "Whoever welcomes one of these little children in my name welcomes me".

Studies show that 85% of those who make a decision to follow Jesus do so between the ages of 4 and 14! That is a huge opportunity lost if we don't become more serious and strategic about reaching children for Christ.

We want to see souls saved - it starts with Children!

After hiring a children's ministry consultant, we learned that utilizing the West Wing as a new Children's Center will allows us to do the following:

Create an easy, secure children's check-in space Give us the space needed for energy-based teaching Allow for us to be more guest-friendly Energize both existing and new families with a renewed focus/passion for kids.

The new plans for the space will include: a stage for teaching (including interactive puppet space), kitchenette, arts and crafts, indoor game space, indoor playground space, and a secure check-in point for parents.

These fabulous designs were created by our very own Kingdom Kids team led by Steven Stokes. We can't wait to see how God will use this space to help children discover and deliver the hope of Jesus!

While this area will be primarily used for kids, it can still be utilized for other events including classes, parties, community rental opportunities, etc.



Focus # 2 Help Non-members Become Family Faster

We have a rich heritage and wonderful history of loving each other. However, the leadership has recognized that we don't necessarily make it easy for new people to become family. After a year of praying, researching, and tracking, we realized that many have come to Mt. Hope but not many have stayed. We want to change that outcome!
