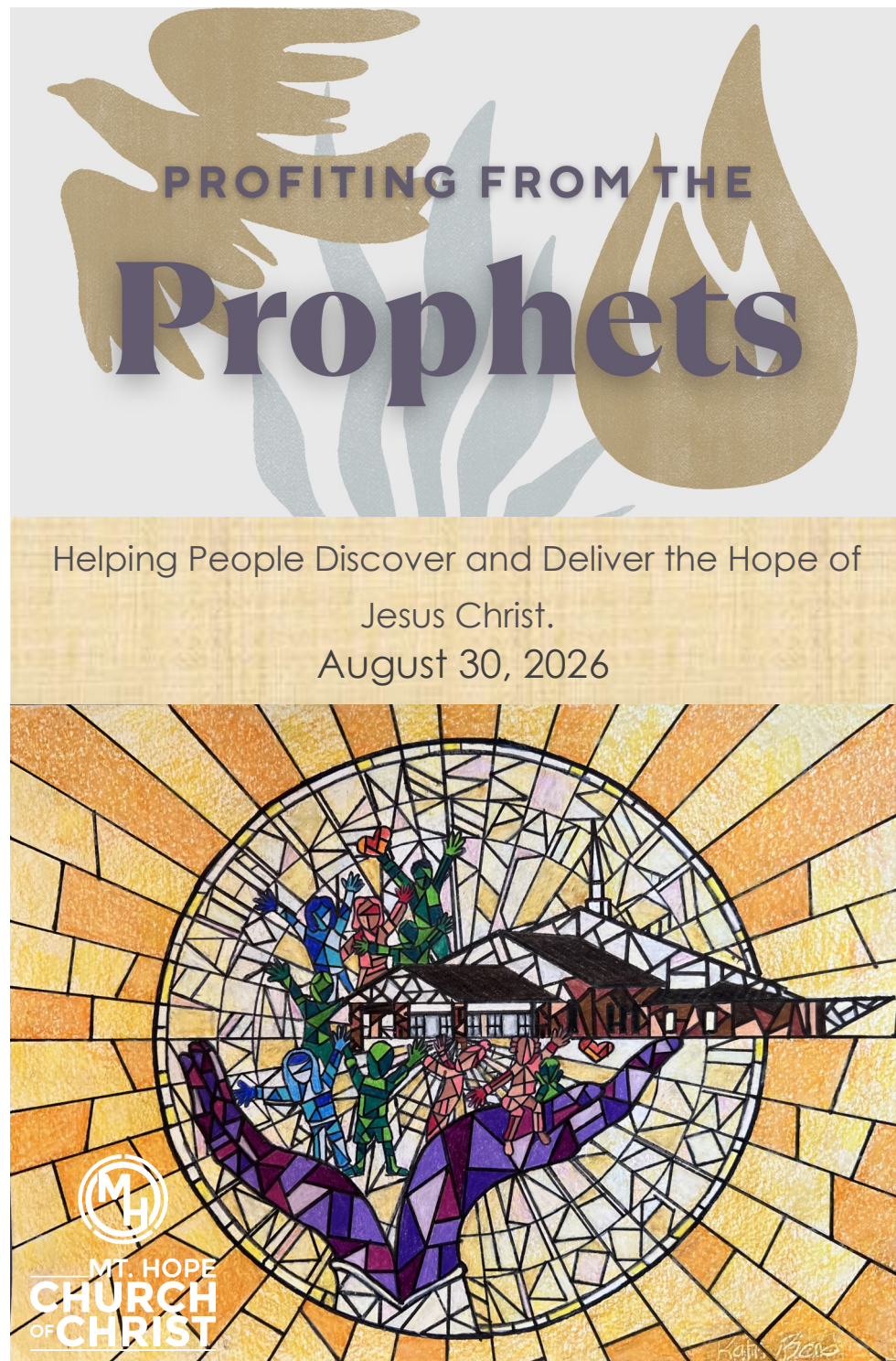

JOEL, THE PROPHET OF PENTECOST

Text: Joel 2:28-29; Acts 2:15-18

Joel prophesied the Great Day of Pentecost! "This is that!"

I. DEVASTATION: The Sign of Judgment (1:1-2:11)

God sent a terrible plague of locusts upon the land.

II. SUPPLICATION: The Call to Repentance (2:12-17)

This was followed by a terrible drought across the land.

III. RESTORATION: A Vision of Blessing (2:18-3:21)

God promises to restore prior and future blessings.

Note: "America's Pentecost" took place August 6-12, 1801, at the historic Cane Ridge Revival near Paris, KY. See Victor's article in the August Knowlesletter! This year is the 225th anniversary of the Cane Ridge Revival, which many historians see as the birthplace of the American Restoration Movement, of which Mt. Hope Church of Christ is kin too.
