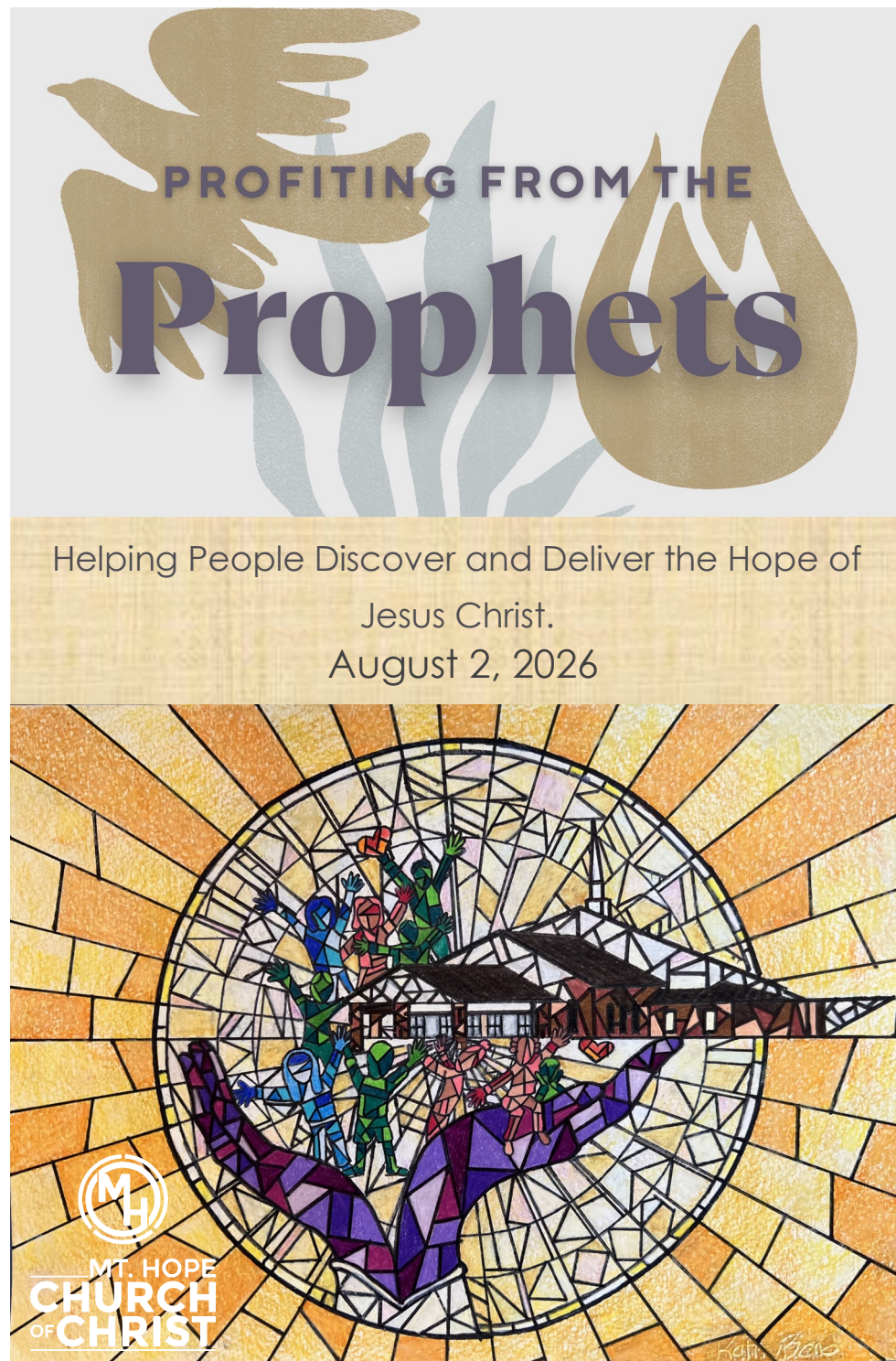

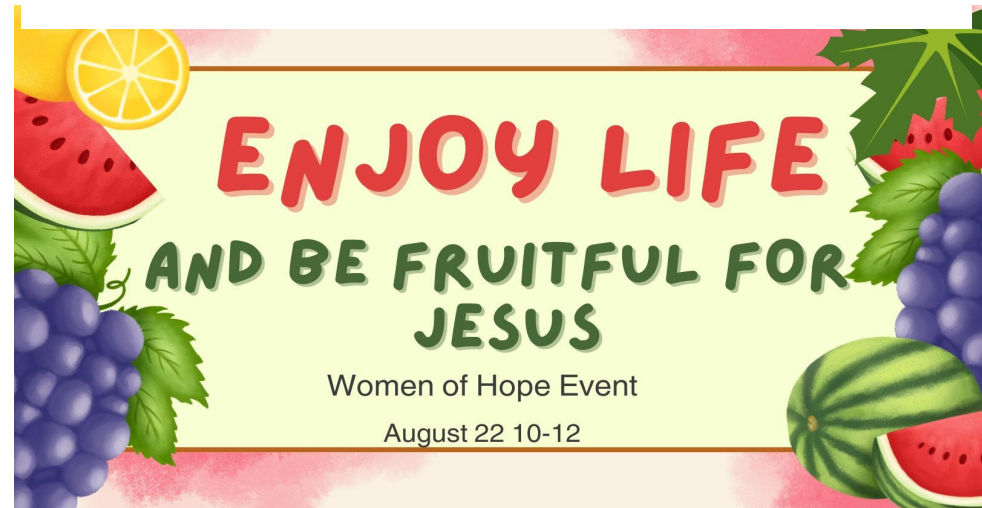

Victor Knowles
Let Justice Roll Down Like Water
Amos 5:21-24

Our theme in Amos is “The Lion *Speaks* Tonight.” The Lion still roars! What does God, through Amos, speak to us today? Much. For instance...

1. God still wants us to take Him seriously.
2. God still wants us to return to Him (4:6, 8-11)
3. God still wants us to seek Him and live (5:4-6, 14)
4. God still despises assemblies that are formal, heartless and meaningless (5:21, 23)
5. God still demands the twin virtues of justice and righteousness from His people (5:24)
6. God still considers complacency worthy of a "woe!" (6:1, 7)
7. God is still full capable of sending a spiritual famine on the land (8:11-12)
8. God can still give the command and “shake the house of Israel!” (9:9)
9. God still forgives and restores those who repent and seek His forgiveness (9:11, 14-15)

And that’s how the book ends. You can choose to believe it or not. At the Jerusalem Council in AD 50, the apostle James stood up and quoted Amos 9 to show that the Gentiles would be included in God’s wonderful kingdom (Acts 15:15-18). He was delighted that Gentiles were turning to God and being added to the universal kingdom of God. Since you are a Gentile, you should be delighted too!
